


- **Students** are the reason we exist. They are at the heart of all we do and our commitment to providing them a transformational experience is unparalleled.



Spring 2021

- Unrestricted expenditures are also in line with expectations through the first half of the year
- Variances in the first half financial results are, primarily, a product of the timing of some annual charges (i.e. IT)



Financial First Half Results

- CARES funding of \$3.6M was received and used for Student Relief and Institutional Expenses to address the ongoing pandemic.
- An additional round of CARES funding has been allocated with \$2.7M granted to Montana Tech. Planned expenditures for the institutional portion of the funds are being evaluated.
- Successful fundraising activities for the Nursing SIM Center has freed incremental Montana Tech funding to invest in the S&E building for upgrades and renovations.
