DR. EMILY ROLAND SPEAKING ON CAMPUS

Montana Tech's Public Lecture Series will host Dr. Emily Roland from Western Washington University on **November 10, 2021** at 4:00 p.m. Her presentation is titled, *"Toques, Whales & lots of Seismometers: Exploring North America's Fastest-slipping Fault System."* Dr. Emily Roland is an Assistant Professor at Western Washington University. Her research is focused on exploring how the structure of the Earth influences earthquakes, and sometimes landslide and tsunami susceptibility. The ZOOM-only presentation can be accessed here.

ASMT and Chancellor Cook will collect food donations from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm on November 15 in the SUB to kick-off the event. When you drop off your donations, you will receive a Montana Tech sticker and cookies! All registered team boxes will be in the SUB from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm on the 15th. After 1:00 pm, the boxes will be moved to the specified location noted in the Qualtrics survey. The top three clubs that collect the most food will win \$300, \$200, and \$100 for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. The top Faculty and Staff Team will win a "Food Wars Champion Trophy" and a party package supplied by Chancellor Cook. Winners will be announced on November 19.
