MBMG GEOHAZARDS PROGRAM

The **Montana Bureau of Mines and Geology (MBMG) Geohazards Program** was recently awarded a grant (FY 2022) from the National Earthquake Hazards Reduction Program and FEMA Individual State Earthquake Assistance through the Montana Department of Emergency Service. The project will identify all potentially active faults and landslides in Powell County using new Lidar data. This investigation will create new peer-reviewed published maps and an interactive online database. These maps will provide references for mitigation strategies, and recommendations for more detailed study. New datasets of active faults will allow the US Geological Survey to include them in the next update to the National Seismic Hazard Maps. [Read more](#)
