Secondary Nursing Application Process

The Sherry Lesar School of Nursing admits 30 students each semester to a clinical seat. However, in the event there are low applicant numbers in the spring for fall admission, a secondary process may be enacted.

Secondary application process:

This process is applicable to any student who has met the 68% TEAS score eligibility requirements to apply to the Sherry Lesar School of Nursing.

Student capacity

- The Director of Nursing will make the decision to enact this process *no later* than June 1st.
- The number of available seats will be determined by the number of applicants who accept placement during the primary application process.
- Secondary applicants may use any eligible TEAS score earned within the academic year.
- The applicant may choose to retake the TEAS exam one additional time. If the student chooses to retake the TEAS exam, the most recent score will be accepted for application.
- A TEAS exam review session will be offered to any student wishing to retake the TEAS exam and is strongly advised.

Additional Secondary Application Details

- Prerequisite courses must be completed by August 5th, 2024 to be eligible for the secondary application process.
- The secondary application process will have **no impact** on applicants from the primary application process who have accepted placement by June 28th.
- The secondary application process targets pre-nursing students who have an established relationship and have been communicating with the nursing department.

Important Dates: secondary application process

- The TEAS test is scheduled in person at Montana Tech for Wednesday May 29th from 8am-12pm. The TEAS test must be paid for (\$70) in advance with the business office and the receipt submitted to the Nursing Department no later than Friday May 24th at 12pm. Please contact Program Assistant, Misty Jonas, mjonas@mtech.edu, for more information if you wish to take the TEAS remotely proctored by ATI.
- Secondary Applications will be due by June 28, 2024, no later than 4pm.
- Selected applicants from secondary process will be notified *no later* than August 14, 2023. (Earlier notification may occur depending on approval of any final summer grades.)
