Presenting Your Project

All URP students are **REQUIRED** to publicly present their research results.

The traditional URP deliverable is an oral presentation at the Montana Academy of Sciences (MAS) Annual Meeting, usually held on the Montana Tech campus in April.

RAMP students must present their research results in a poster at TECHXPO in April on the Montana Tech campus.

SURF students must present their research results in a poster form at the SURF Poster Symposium at Tech in August.

Students doing Public Health Internships (PHI) during the academic year may present at MAS, while those involved in SURF would participate in the SURF Poster Symposium.

Presentations:

MAS - Each presentation room will be set up for PowerPoint presentations. Bring an electronic copy of your PowerPoint presentation on a flash drive and bring a backup copy in your email as an emergency source. Presentations last 15 minutes, including approximately 3 minutes for questions.

TECHXPO – Posters are printed by the Administrative Associate in Mining or PTC. The template and instructions will be provided to each RAMP project participant at the orientation meeting. The URP office will pay the cost of printing one poster. If changes are needed, the student and mentor are responsible for the cost.

SURF POSTER SYMPOSIUM - Posters are printed by the Administrative Associate in Mining or PTC. The template and instructions will be provided to each SURF project participant at a workshop. The URP office will pay the cost of printing one poster. If changes are needed, the student and mentor are responsible for the cost.
